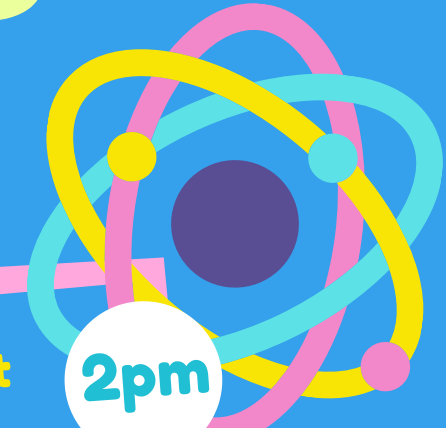
You'll need: Lego, access to Zoom.

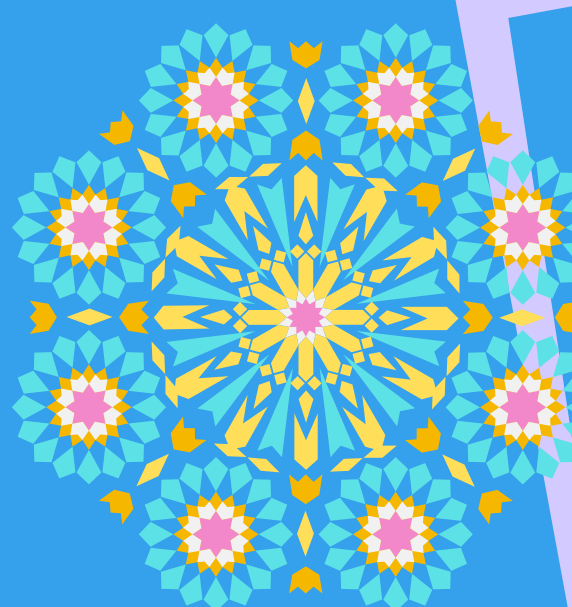


Tuesday 22 Sept Crazy Kaleidoscopes

- Sewing needle with eye large enough to take your thread/yarn
