



Realm Library ArtBoxes – Exhibition Terms & Conditions

Insurance

Insurance of works on display is the responsibility of the Exhibitor. Eastern Regional Library Corporation (ERLC) is not responsible for any damage, theft or mishap that may occur to art works while on exhibit at Realm, or to and from the exhibition.

Content and Presentation of work

Works must be suitable to display on bookshelf style shelving, as no wall hanging opportunity exists.

The Exhibitor must provide the details of all works on display as requested in the online Expression of Interest Form. Works must remain on display for the entire period of the exhibition (unless otherwise negotiated).

Delivery and Collection of Work

Exhibitors are responsible for transporting works to and from the exhibition together with any costs involved in transportation.

All works must be removed on the final day of the exhibition.

Please note, there is no storage space available in the library for artworks to be stored prior to, during, or after, the exhibition dates.

Installation and maintenance of the exhibits

The Exhibitor is responsible for the installation of the work/s.

Library staff and patrons must not be exposed to any unsafe work practices in the installation or deinstallation of exhibitions.

Exhibitors are responsible for their own actions, risks or any injury arising from the installation or deinstallation of the exhibit. ERLC will accept no responsibility for the same.

If the exhibition requires any specific maintenance during the exhibit period, this is the responsibility of the Exhibitor.

Supervision of the Exhibition

The exhibition space is not under direct staff supervision, although library staff are on the premises at all times during opening hours. Constant supervision, if required, is the responsibility of the Exhibitor.

ERLC takes no responsibility for the care of the artworks while in the library. Any lost or damaged items are entirely the responsibility of the Exhibitor.

Sale of works

ERLC supports Exhibitors selling their works; however, sales and any associated financial transactions are the sole responsibility of the Exhibitor.

Exhibitors should exercise discretion if undertaking any negotiations or financial transactions on the library premises.

ERLC will not be held liable for any loss or misplacement of monies arising from the sale of exhibits.

Content of work/s

Exhibitors are responsible for complying with copyright, censorship and other laws and must observe all applicable Federal, State and Local Laws. This includes: displaying material that in any way breaches or infringes copyright, patents or any other intellectual property rights; re-using or sharing content without acknowledgement to the original author; copying work from a source without being authorised to do so.

ERLC's resources and exhibition spaces must not be used to display any material that is fraudulent, harassing, threatening, bullying, embarrassing, sexually explicit, profane, obscene, racist, sexist, intimidating, defamatory, insulting, homophobic or otherwise inappropriate or unlawful.

Exhibitors must not use the ERLC's resources and exhibition spaces to display material that violates laws relating to child pornography.

Exhibitors must not knowingly exhibit or display any material which is harmful to minors in its content, or material that is obscene in any place of public accommodation where minors are or may be present and where minors are able to view the material.

Submissions that feature works that defame; libel; ridicule; or disparage any person or organization, or are discriminatory or otherwise inappropriate, will not be accepted.

Disclaimer

Under no circumstances shall ERLC, nor individual library staff members, be liable for any direct, indirect, incidental, exemplary or consequential damages (including, but not limited to, loss of art works, use, or profits, or interruption, or safety of equipment or spaces) however caused and on any theory of liability (including negligence or otherwise) arising in any way out of the use of the resources or exhibition spaces provided by ERLC, even if advised of the possibility of such damage.

General

ERLC's resources and exhibition spaces must not be used for any illegal, unauthorized or dangerous purpose and must be used in accordance with Victorian and Commonwealth of Australia laws, and the policies and by-laws of the Corporation.

Exhibitors must not engage in any activity that interferes with the ability of Patrons to use the library and its resources.

Release

By using ERLC's resources, Exhibitors release and discharge ERLC from any liability which might arise from the use of the resources including liability in relation to defamatory or offensive material or any breach of copyright which may occur as a result of use.

Breach of Terms & Conditions

The Branch Manager Realm Library, or their delegate, is entitled to determine what constitutes a breach of these Terms & Conditions.
