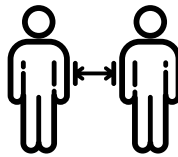
Our library customers should note the following advice:



Do not enter the library if you have COVID, cold or flu symptoms, or feel unwell



Wearing face masks is strongly recommended



Maintain physical distancing guidelines



Sanitise your hands on entering the building, after using any equipment or handling books, DVDs, etc. and visiting the toilets. Hand sanitiser stations are at the entrance to the building and in key locations around the library



Cover coughs and sneezes

Keeping our customers and staff safe from illness remains a high priority for *Your Library*.

Once in the library, wearing face masks is strongly recommended for both our customers and staff.

If you choose not to wear a mask, or display COVID, cold or flu symptoms during your visit to the library we may need to change how we interact with you.

Customers must comply with all directives from the nominated Officer-In-Charge, which may include being asked to leave the library if you show significant signs of illness.

If a customer requires help with technology or our collections, we ask you to respect our physical distancing guidelines for your health and safety of you and that of our staff.
